SERMON COMMENTARY

1. Judah who betrayed Jesus

My beloved friend, Jesus was arrested even though He was innocent. His disciples left Him, and Judas told the soldiers about Jesus. Why did all of this happen? It was part of God's plan. God had a special plan for us because we have sins and cannot go to heaven on our own. That's why someone needed to take our sins away. Wouldn't it be great if there was something in the supermarket that could get rid of our sins? But in this world, there is nothing that can remove sins. That's why God sent His Son, Jesus, who was without sin, to us. So Jesus was arrested and crucified. After that, He took away all our sins by sacrificing Himself on the cross. If we repent of our sins, we receive forgiveness. Because of Jesus' sacrifice and love, we have become children of God and people of heaven. We should be thankful and show love to Jesus every day.

2. Lies

My beloved friend. Peter denied Jesus because he was scared of people. Even though Peter had seen many miracles and experienced love, he lied. Peter was scared. But when the rooster crowed twice, he remembered what Jesus had said and felt sorry for lying. We also lie to Jesus sometimes. On Sundays, when we're supposed to go to church, if something fun happens, we might choose to watch TV, hang out with friends, sleep in, or go to the playground instead of going to church. Since we are God's children, it's important for us to go to church and worship. Also, when our friends bother us, we often don't forgive them and feel angry. Jesus told us to love everyone. Let's forgive and love our friends so that they can meet Jesus. That love is God's love, and it shows that we are God's children. Let's pray that we can be like that. Just like Peter lied and cried before Jesus, let's pray to Jesus and say sorry for our mistakes. And let's try to have faith and become God's children. We have received Jesus' love, so let's share that love with our friends and family. That love will make God happy.

3. Jesus washing his disciples' feet

My beloved friend. Jesus said that washing the disciples' feet was a way to show love. Back then, people walked in the desert, and their shoes were different from ours, so their feet got very dusty. Jesus showed them how to help those who needed it. Let's think about who needs us, like our parents or friends. We can show them a lot of love. We should listen to our parents, pray for them, and express love to our family. And let's praise and encourage each other with joy. Every day, tell your family you love them and are thankful. They will be so happy. This way, people will see Jesus' love in us. Show kindness and love to your friends too. Compliment them, be understanding, and care for them, sharing Jesus' love. Just like Jesus washed the disciples' feet, let's also take care of our neighbors and friends. Jesus will say, "Well done!" and praise us.

4. Last dinner with Jesus

My beloved friend. Jesus gave bread to the disciples and said it is His body. He did this to take our sins upon Himself and make us children of God. Jesus was nailed to the cross for our sins to be forgiven. He also referred to the wine as His blood. It symbolizes how Jesus took our sins upon Himself, endured the nails in His hands and feet, wore a crown of thorns on His head, and shed His blood for us. Through His loving sacrifice, we can pray to Jesus and ask for forgiveness, and our sins will be forgiven. This is the love of Jesus on the cross. With this love, we can be freed from sin and enter the kingdom of heaven. Let's be grateful for this love and follow the Ten Commandments, love our neighbors, attend Sunday worship, and give thanks in all things, showing that we are children of God. Jesus will cheer for us when He sees us doing these things. Now let's share Jesus with our friends through this love.

5. The trial of Jesus

My beloved friend. Even the judge, Pilate, knew that Jesus was innocent. But the people who saw Jesus perform miracles shouted for Him to be crucified. How could this happen? It was because the chief priests and elders envied and hated Jesus. They made up false stories to make people hate Him. We shouldn't lie like them. We should always be truthful and live righteously. Jesus wants us to be like that. He prays for us to have good hearts and be good people. Let's take this time to repent and pray, asking Jesus to forgive us for any bad thoughts, lies, wrong actions, jealousy, or hatred in our hearts. Jesus will be delighted by our sincere efforts.

6. Jesus is nailed to a cross

My beloved friend. Why did Jesus, who did nothing wrong, choose to carry the cross? It was part of God's plan. God sent His Son, Jesus, to the world to help us and take away our sins. We humans cannot forgive our own sins, so God sent Jesus to do it for us. Jesus was sinless, which allowed Him to take on our sins. That's why He came to Earth in human form and was crucified on the cross. Because of Jesus' sacrifice, we can receive the grace of forgiveness for our sins. By believing in Jesus and admitting our sins, we can become God's children and be saved. This means we can go to heaven. Let's express our gratitude, praise, and love to Jesus. Let's be thankful for His love. Share Jesus' love with our family, friends, and neighbors.

7. The thief on the cross was saved

Thank you, Jesus. We love you for saving us.

My beloved friend. We need to make good choices while observing two robbers. One robber made fun of Jesus and missed the chance to be saved. The other robber recognized himself as a sinner and repented, humbly asking Jesus to save him. As a result, he believed in Jesus and was able to enter heaven. We can also be saved and go to heaven if we confess our sins to Jesus. Jesus sacrificed Himself on the cross to bring us to heaven. By believing in Jesus alone and confessing our sins, we receive forgiveness through the love of Jesus, who shed His blood on the cross for us. We are thankful to Jesus for giving us salvation. Let's love Jesus with all our hearts and not be afraid of death, focusing our love, faith, and hope only on Him.

8. Death of Jesus

My beloved friend. Why didn't Jesus perform miracles to save Himself? Why didn't He say anything when people arrested Him and nailed Him to the cross? Even though Jesus is God's Son, why did He choose to endure pain? All of this was part of God's plan. God wanted to send us to heaven, but our sins were a problem. So, He sent Jesus to us, and by dying on the cross, our sins could be forgiven, and we could be saved. Jesus' death was the way for us to receive forgiveness. He took our sins upon Himself, even though He was without sin, and opened the path to heaven for us. We only need to believe in Jesus, confess our sins, and turn away from them, and Jesus will forgive us and change our destination from condemnation to heaven. My friends, we are now children of God and can worship Jesus and God in heaven. Let's express our gratitude and love to Jesus with our hearts. Let's rejoice, give thanks with joy, and meet the Lord in worship. Jesus will accept all our love for him

9. Jesus has risen

My beloved friend. Jesus rose from the dead after three days, but His disciples were not there. That could be our reflection. Many people witnessed Jesus' miracles but did not believe. Let's also consider our faith through Jesus' resurrection. Do we truly believe in Jesus, the Son of God? Does our faith confess that He is the Son of God within our hearts? Do we believe that Jesus died on the cross because of our sins, washed away our sins, and rose again after three days? Do we believe that if we believe in Jesus, confess our sins to Him, and ask for forgiveness, we can become God's children and go to heaven? Jesus will ask about our faith. In that moment, let's show Him our faith. Let's confess our hearts to Jesus, saying, "Jesus, I believe that You are the son of God, who went to the cross for me and rose again after three days. I thank You for forgiving my sins."

Through this confession, Jesus will know our faith in our hearts. Let's all confess to Jesus right now!

10. Touch me and see

My beloved friend. Jesus has risen again. He also appeared to His disciples. Thomas, who had doubts, couldn't believe it, so Jesus asked him to touch His hands and side. Jesus allowed Thomas to touch Him, and that's when Thomas believed. What about our faith? Is it a faith filled with doubt, like Thomas? Or do we believe in Jesus' words, obey them, and live accordingly?

Let's pray for faith. Jesus rose again after three days. He is an amazing God. Through Jesus, our wonderful God showed that He is the Son of God. Our loving God has revealed to us that we, too, are God's children through Jesus. We receive this amazing love from our God. Every day, share the love of Jesus with your family and friends with gratitude and joy. And every day, confess your love for Jesus.

11. Peter's confession

My beloved friend. How can we respond to Jesus' question? "Do you love me?" Let's answer in our hearts right now. If Jesus asked us three times, just like He did with Peter, how would you answer each time? If our beloved Jesus, who carried the cross for us, died and rose again, asked us if we love Him, I believe we would all say, "I love you, Jesus. Jesus, I love you so much."

Who in this world can bear the cross and die in my place? How can we not love Him who forgave our sins and sacrificed His life for us? Our parents may be willing to die for us, but they cannot forgive our sins. Yet, Jesus took all our sins upon Himself. How is it possible that only Jesus could do this? Because Jesus is the son of God. Every day, let's confess our love to Jesus, worship Him with gratitude, and show our love to Him as His children who share His love with others.

12. What we must do

My beloved friend. Jesus told us to tell others about Him. He said we should believe in Him and get baptized, and encourage our family, neighbors, and friends to do the same. Through baptism, Jesus shows us how to believe in Him and gives us the power of the Holy Spirit. Our Lord Jesus has gifted us with baptism, and through it, He grants us the grace of salvation. Now, when we believe in Him, we receive salvation, which allows us to enter the kingdom of heaven. Let us express our gratitude and love for Jesus through daily praise and worship. And let's follow Jesus' command to share the good news with everyone in the world, our family, neighbors, and friends. Jesus will be very happy when we do this. Let's be good friends who do our homework well.

13. Jesus will come just like he went into heaven

My beloved friend. Jesus rose from the dead and taught His disciples for 40 days. He promised to return to us when He ascended to heaven. Isn't that amazing? Jesus is coming back again! Although He hasn't come yet, we are grateful and joyful because we will live with Him in heaven, praising God in eternity. We believe in Jesus' promise and wait before God in prayer. By keeping His commandments with faith, we can wait faithfully. We just need to share the message of Jesus, love our neighbors, and live according to God's word. Let's praise Jesus every day, expressing our love and gratitude, and pray to Him. While eagerly waiting for Jesus to return as He ascended, let's actively spread the good news. Jesus will surely praise us for our efforts when He comes back.

Jesus will remember your prayers and help you all. Let's never give up but pray and strive to lead others to believe in Jesus. Let's share Jesus' love with others, just as He loved and saved us. Jesus will be so happy about it.

15. Stephen was stoned to death

My beloved friends. Stephen was a servant of God who was full of grace and power. He took care of and helped many people, so he was well-liked by them. However, some bad people and elders made false accusations against Stephen and unfairly twisted his words to make him look guilty. Even the high priest didn't understand Stephen. As Paul opened his eyes by meeting Jesus, Let's also just follow Jesus` voice in our life.


